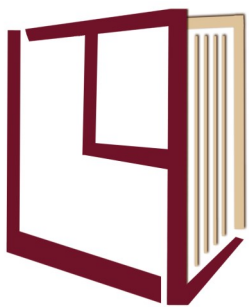

From the Director's Desk

With summer comes the construction season and so it will be this year at the library. Construction should be underway by the 1st of June with substantial completion at the end of September and everything should be completed by the end of October. I am so happy to be saying this; it has been a long road getting to the beginning of our project.

Needless to say the library will be a bit chaotic this summer as we are trying to remain open during construction. There will be times that the stairway will be inaccessible and we will have to use the elevator. There will be times that one of the entries may be closed and certain areas of the library will be inaccessible. So we ask that you bear with us as we make the interior a better place for all of us. I can guarantee you it will be noisy in here often. Staff will be displaced occasionally so bear with us if we seem discombobulated!

One of the new features we have added for ease of use for you are two self-checkout machines on the upper level. They are temporarily located across from the circulation desk. You may check out your materials yourself unless you have DVDs or you owe a fine. The machines are very easy to use. We encourage you to try, and staff would be happy to show you how they work.

We have also put hold materials on the floor near the self-checkout machines for you to retrieve on your own. They have special labels with the first four letters of your last name and the last four numbers of your library card number for identification purposes. You can then step to a self-check machine and check out yourself. If you prefer, you may stop at the desk and they will check out materials for you.

We hope that this summer you manage to find some time to enjoy the weather in solitude or with family and friends. We hope that your favorite baseball team continues to play well. How nice that both sides of town are off to a fabulous start! Go Cubs and Go Sox! Remember to use your library for your reading, listening and DVD binge watching pleasure. Perhaps you have noticed we have eliminated the \$1 fee for renting DVDs!

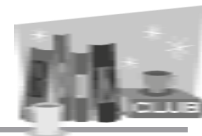




