

Lansing library to add four computer terminals

LANSING — As part of the upgrade to its computer system, the Lewis O. Flom Lansing Public Library will buy four new computer terminals.

The library board last week authorized Library Director Janice Bojda to order four T1200 Wyse terminals and three lasers used for material check-outs. Three of the terminals will be for material check-out and one will be for data entry. All of the purchases will re-

place existing equipment.

The new equipment is not expected to arrive before May, Bojda said. The library's actual cost will be about \$8,000.

In other matters, the board began preliminary discussions of next fiscal year's budget and some salary adjustments. The board approved an increase in the minimum hourly wage from \$3.80 to \$4.25 to comply with federal requirements.

The higher hourly rate will be effective April 1. The new rate will mostly affect library pages.
