

# Lansing library board OKs bond sale

LANSING — A \$400,000 bond sale was approved Wednesday night to pay for a new roof for the Lansing Public Library.

Library officials Wednesday awarded a \$139,400 roofing con-

tract to the lowest bidder, Bennett and Brosseau Roofing of Kankakee.

The initial roofing work for the library, at 2750 Indiana Ave., is scheduled to be done on weekends during July and August.

"They want to be in and out by the end of August," project ar-

chitect Edwin Lugowski said.

Lugowski told board members he expected to have the final contract completed within 10 days for signature.

Bids on replacing ceiling tiles inside the library may be let at the July 16 meeting, board members said.

Board members said the bonds would be repaid over a five-year period. The \$400,000 was based on estimates received for the total project, they said.

The library is also proposing to increase its tax levy to help pay for the roof repairs.
