# Library Gets Memorial

LANSING—When Glenn A. Pawlowski was fatally injured one year ago, his electronic knowledge and abilities were lost to science. Glenn, the son of Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Pawlowski of Bernice Road, was a graduate of De Vry Institute of Electronics and was employed in that field.

Glenn's family and friends have donated a collection of electronics books to the Lansing Library. The first group of books contained educational-technical material. The second group which has

just arrived at the library will be helpful to young children.

Mrs. Pawlowski said, "We hope the electronics library will inspire other young people to enter the field, and aid those now studying electronics."

Mrs. Robert Jensen, librarian said the Pawlowski contribution was one of the largest in the history of the library. Glenn's parents say they hope others will follow the lead and "find there is no more lasting memorial than a library to enrich the lives of young people."
